

India rejects unwarranted Kashmir reference

NEW DELHI: India on Thursday categorically rejected unwarranted references to the UTs of Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh in the joint statement between China and Pakistan and said the territories are an integral part of India and no other country has the locus standi to comment on them.

The statement by the Ministry of External Affairs spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal, also rejected references in the joint statement to India's sovereign territory under forcible and illegal occupation by Pakistan in the China-Pakistan Economic Corridor.

The statement read:
"We have noted unwarranted references to the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir in the joint statement between China and Pakistan on 07 June 2024.

"We categorically reject such references. Our position on the issue is consistent and well known to the concerned parties. The Union Ter-



ritory of Jammu and Kashmir and the Union Territory of Ladakh have been, and will always remain integral and inalienable parts of India. No other country has the locus standi to comment on the same.

"The same joint statement also mentions activities and projects under the so-called China-Pakistan

Economic Corridor (CPEC), some of which are in India's sovereign territory under forcible and illegal occupation by Pakistan.

"We resolutely oppose and reject any moves by other countries to reinforce or legitimise Pakistan's illegal occupation of these territories, impinging on India's sovereignty and territorial integrity."

The joint statement, issued during Pakistan PM Shehbaz Sharif's visit to China while referring to J&K, had said: "The Pakistani side briefed the Chinese side on the latest developments of the situation in Jammu and Kashmir. The Chinese side reiterated that the Jammu and Kashmir dispute is left over from history, and should be properly and peacefully resolved in accordance with the UN Charter, relevant UN Security Council resolutions and bilateral agreements."

Sunetra Pawar to be made Rajya Sabha MP

PUNE: Deputy Chief Minister Ajit Pawar's wife, Sunetra Pawar, will be made Rajya Sabha member, said Pune Nationalist Congress Party (AP) president Deepak Mankar here on Thursday.

Mankar said: "Sunetra tai will be sent to Rajya Sabha. It was decided last night Sunetra Pawar's name will be nominated for the June 25 Rajya Sabha by-elections."



It was finalised in a meeting called by Ajit Pawar with party ministers at his official residence in Mumbai, added Mankar. Mankar said the party workers had already raised the demand to nominate her for Rajya Sabha and it was finally okayed. Sunetra Pawar lost from Baramati in the recently concluded Lok Sabha elections

against NCP (SP) candidate Supriya Sule.

Mankar said that NCP (AP) working president Praful Patel proposed the name of Sunetra Pawar in the meeting and asked the ministers to express their views.

Agriculture Minister Dhananjay Munde supported Praful Patel's proposal saying that it will boost the morale of party workers.

The election is likely to take place unopposed as the Mahayuti has 180 MLAs.

PK Mishra re-appointed Principal Secretary

NEW DELHI: The government on Thursday announced that PK Mishra has been re-appointed as Principal Secretary to Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

According to an official statement, the appointment has been done with effect from June 10, the day Modi took oath as PM for his third consecutive term. "His appointment will be co-terminus with the term of the Prime Minister or until further orders whichever is earlier," said the statement.

Mishra has been assigned the rank of Cabinet Minister in the Table of Precedence. The Government also appointed senior bureaucrats -- Amit Khare and Tarun Kapoor -- as Advisors to the Prime Minister in the Prime Minister's Office and they will serve in the rank of Secretary.

Jarange suspends his hunger strike

JALNA: Manoj Jarange-Patil, who is on hunger strike at Antarwali Sarati in the district for his demand of reservation for Maratha community, suspended his fast on sixth day on Thursday following a meeting with a delegation of the Maharashtra government. The delegation, led by state Cabinet minister Sambhuraaj Desai, Shinde Sena MP Sandipan Bhumre and BJP MLA Rana Jagjitsinh, met him and requested him to withdraw his agitation.

When Desai informed quota activist about the work going on at the government level regarding his demands,

Jarange-Patil told him that he had given them enough time, but the government is not working at the right pace. To which, the minister attributed delay in decision-making process to the code of conduct which was in force due to the Lok Sabha elections in the state for last two months. "I will hold a meeting with concerned officers tomorrow (Friday) and will arrive at a final decision on the 'Sagesoire' (blood relatives) notification as early as possible," Desai promised. Following which, Jarange-Patil decided to suspend his fast and gave a month's time to the government to act on

his demands. "I am giving you a month's time, so the government can decide on all his demands by July 13, otherwise we will defeat the candidates in upcoming state assembly elections," he added. Jarange-Patil's demands are implementation of 'Sagesoire' notification, legislation proclaiming that Marathas and Kunbis are one, withdrawal of cases against Maratha protesters across the state, give reservation to the Marathas based on Hyderabad Gazette and grant extension of one year to the Shinde Committee constituted to search for Kunbi records.

Warrant against Yediyurappa

BENGALURU: A Bengaluru court on Thursday issued a non-bailable arrest warrant against former Chief Minister and senior BJP leader B S Yediyurappa in a POCSO case.

The crime investigation department, probing the Pro-

tection of Children from Sexual Offences Act case against Yediyurappa, had earlier summoned him for questioning. He, however, had sought time to appear before the investigation officer of the CID.

The Bharatiya Janata Party veteran, who is also a member

of the party's parliamentary board, is presently in Delhi, and he is likely to join the probe after he returns, sources close to him have said.

According to the police, Yediyurappa has been booked under the POCSO Act and Section 354 A (sex-

ual harassment) of the Indian Penal Code based on a complaint by the mother of a 17-year-old girl who alleged that he sexually assaulted her daughter during a meeting on February two this year, at his residence in Dollars Colony in Bengaluru.

Severe heatwave conditions in Himachal

SHIMLA: The India Meteorological Department (IMD) in Shimla has issued a heatwave warning for the next 72 hours for several districts in Himachal Pradesh, including Sirmour, Bilaspur, Chamba, Hamirpur, Kangra, Kullu, Mandi, Shimla, Solan, and Una.

There is a potential for severe heatwave conditions at one or two locations, the IMD warned.

The heatwave has significantly impacted the region, with temperatures soaring above 44 degrees Celsius in the plains. Una recorded a maximum temperature of 42.1°C, which

is 7.8°C above normal. Neri experienced a blistering 44.6°C. In Bilaspur, the temperature reached 42.7°C, 4.8°C higher than usual, while Hamirpur saw 42.1°C, 5.2°C above normal. Kangra recorded 41.8°C, a departure from normal by 5.3°C, and Sundernagar hit 41.3°C, 6.8°C above the usual. Bhuntar's maximum temperature was 38.5°C, 5.7°C higher than average, and Mandi recorded 41.1°C, 6.5°C above the norm. Nahan experienced 39.9°C, 6.4°C above normal. Shimla, the capital town, has also been ex-

periencing unusually high temperatures, with the maximum temperature remaining above 30.5°C for the last three days, reaching 30.6°C Thursday. The prolonged heatwave has exacerbated forest fire incidents, particularly in pine forests, causing significant damage. Official reports indicate around 1300 fire incidents, leading to substantial loss of life and property. The lack of pre-monsoon rain is also threatening agricultural activities, particularly Kharif sowing and off-season vegetable cultivation.

5 killed in blast

NAGPUR: At least five workers were killed in a blast at an explosives manufacturing factory near Nagpur city on Thursday afternoon, police said.

The incident took place at Chamundi Explosive Pvt Ltd at Dhanna village under Hingna police station limits, around 25 km from Nagpur.

"At least five persons were killed...the whole factory has been gutted," said Nagpur police commissioner Ravindra Singh, talking to the media.

The explosion took place around 1 pm when the workers were packing explosives, said a local police official.

'45 Indians killed'

NEW DELHI: Kuwaiti authorities have identified the bodies of 45 Indians and three Filipino nationals killed in the tragic fire incident in a building housing foreign workers in the Gulf Kingdom, a top official said on Thursday.

Khandu sworn in as Arunachal CM



ITANAGAR: Bharatiya Janata Party leader Pema Khandu took oath as the chief minister of Arunachal Pradesh for the third consecutive term on Thursday. Khandu, the MLA of Mukto, was sworn in by Governor K T Parmaik in the presence of Union Home Minister Amit Shah, BJP president J P Nadda, Assam CM Himanta Biswa Sarma and Sikkim Chief Minister

Prem Singh Tamang, among others. Eleven other MLAs were also sworn in as ministers at the function held in the Dorjee Khandu State Convention Centre. Among them were Deputy CM Chowna Mein, former assembly speaker P D Sona, BJP state president Biyuram Wahge, and Dasanglu Pul, the widow of former CM Kalikho Pul.
