Edu insts shut on Thu, Fri; bank holiday only on Friday

Nagpur:29 September: District collector Vipin Itankar has declared a holiday on September 28 for schools and junior colleges, while the state government has declared a holiday on September 29 for all institutes and establishments on account of Eid-E-Milad. Banks and state government offices will hence remain open on Thursday, as the earlier scheduled holiday has now been cancelled. Banks will now be closed on Friday. Nagpur University PRO said no notification had been issued by the registrar so far.

The confusion started because of an evening circular issued by the general administration department (GAD), which changed the Eid holiday from the earlier scheduled September 28 to 29. Since lakhs of students are enrolled in schools across Nagpur district, the education department here was the first off the block to circulate the decision on its letterhead. This left schools with a big problem. The education department's circular arrived around 6.15pm in school WhatsApp groups, and the challenge was to inform all parents about the Thursday holiday getting cancelled. We also published the following articles recently The Maharashtra government has declared September 29 as a holiday for Eid-e-Milad at the request of Muslim leaders. This decision was made because Anant Chaturdashi, the final day of the Ganesh festival, falls on September 28, the same day as Eid-e-Milad. The government's announcement means there will be two consecutive state holidays and a long weekend, followed by a national holiday on October 2. The state government of

Maharashtra in India has declared a public holiday on September 29, in response to appeals from Muslim leaders. The holiday will facilitate processions for Eid-e-Milad, the celebration of Prophet Muhammad's birthday. Muslim leaders had requested the holiday to ensure that the processions can be carried out smoothly. The decision is expected to promote peaceful celebrations for both the Muslim and Hindu communities in the state. The Private Schools Association in Bengaluru has requested local authorities to announce in advance whether Friday will be a holiday for schools due to a bandh against the release of Cauvery water to Tamil Nadu. The association advises schools to evaluate the situation and make a decision based on the ground situation. Meanwhile, four FIRs have been registered against two men who vandalized establishments during the bandh. In addition, the Maharashtra government has declared September 29 as a holiday for Eid-e-Milad to accommodate the processions that coincide with the final day of the Ganesh festival.

A 15-year-old girl was raped by seven people including her boyfriend in Khapa

Nagpur 29 September: A 15-year-old girl from a village under Khapa police station of Saoner tehsil was caught in a love trap and raped by seven persons including her boyfriend. Indecent photos and videos of the girl were made and circulated on WhatsApp groups of friends. While the other five accused showed the photo and pressured her to have physical relations. Khapa police have registered a case against 12 persons. The accused has been identified as Dheeraj Hiwarkar, Vedant Awte Golu Likhar, Vikas Hedau,



Lucky Dharma, all were Resident of khapa. Dheeraj Hiwarkar, a young man of the village, cheated the victim by having an affair with her. On March 2, he took her to a secluded house near his house and had physical relations with her. He conspired to defame her by

posting her obscene photos and videos on social media. Through that he used to blackmail her and torture her physically and mentally. Based on that he threatened her and then asked his other friends Nikhil Dhande, Gaurav Khubalkar, Sushil Dharman to have physical relations. When she refused, he threatened to show her photo in the village. Within a few days, accused Dheeraj and Golu Likhar forced her to have physical relations with their village friends Vikas Hedau, Vicky Likhar, Snehal Surkar and Pranoy Tekade. All the above accused circulated the obscene photos of the girl on WhatsApp group. The accused also threatened to show the photos to the father if they did not have physical relations. As 12 youths of the village demanded physical relations, the mental condition and health of the victim deteriorated. Her mother then took her to the hospital. As her condition was not improving, her mother questioned her seriously. She informed her mother about repeated gang.

Cleanliness drive by NMC at 67 spots on Oct 1

Nagpur 29 September: Municipal Corporation has selected 67 spots for the 'Swachhata Hi Sewa' (Cleanliness is the Service) mission to be held between 10 am and 11 am on October 1. Prime Minister Narendra Modi has appealed to the people and social organisations to participate in the mission as a service to society and tribute to Mahatma Gandhi. A cleanliness drive is being implemented from September 15 in the city to October 2. The people should donate labour for one hour under the drive. Additional Commissioner Anchal Goel has expressed confidence that people would participate in the drive to pay homage to Mahatma Gandhi, who worked selflessly for cleanliness.

No more potholes on highways after December

Nagpur 29 September: Union Minister for Road Transport and Highways Nitin Gadkari has set an ambitious target of making all national highways pothole-free by December 2023.



Speaking at a media briefing on Thursday,

Gadkari said a policy is being drafted to ensure pothole-free national highways. Gadkari said that rains can cause damage to highways resulting in potholes and the new policy will look to deal with that. He further added the new policy will also look into the drainage issues along the national highways. He added that another policy being worked on is for the use of municipal waste in road construction.
