# Mastering frontier technologies is need of hour: Rajnath Singh

MHOW: Defence Minister Rajnath Singh on Monday said that mastering frontier technologies in today's constantly-evolving times is the need of the hour, and the military training centres are playing a crucial role in equipping and readying the soldiers to deal with future challenges.

Addressing officers at the Army War College (AWC), Rajnath Singh highlighted the radical changes being witnessed in the ways of warfare, an official statement said.

He said that unconventional methods like information warfare, Artificial Intelligence warfare, proxy warfare, electro-magnetic space warfare and cyber attacks are posing a big challenge in today's times.

He stressed on the need

for military to remain welltrained and equipped to deal with such challenges, lauding the training centres in Mhow for their valuable contribution in these efforts. He also commended the centres for constantly improving their training curriculum, in sync with the changing times, and striving to make the personnel fighting fit for every kind of challenge.

Rajnath reasserted the Government's resolve to strengthen integration and jointness among the three services, exuding confidence that, in the times to come, the Armed Forces will be able to face challenges together in a better and more efficient way.

He appreciated the fact that high-level training is provided to officers of all wings in Mhow Cantonment. He urged the officers to explore the possibility of promoting integration through training in areas such as weapons training in Infantry School; AI and communication

ogy in Military College of Telecommunication Engineering (MCTE); and Leadership - Junior and Senior Command in AWC.

He added that some officers will work as defence attaches in the future, and they should strive to secure national interests at the global level.

"When you take up this post of Defence Attaches, you should imbibe the Government's vision of 'Aatmanirbhar Bharat'. Only through self-reliance can India strengthen its defence capabilities and gain more respect on the world stage,"

"India is constantly moving on the path of development and is rapidly emerging as a manufacturing hub. From a military point of view, we are getting equipped with modern weapons. We are also exporting Made-in-India equipment to other countries. Our defence exports, which were around Rs 2,000 crores a decade ago, have crossed the record figure of Rs 21,000 crore. We have set an export target of Rs 50,000 crore by

# Kharge, Priyanka condemn lathicharge

**NEW DELHI:** Congress president Mallikarjun Kharge and party general secretary Priyanka Gandhi Vadra on Monday termed the lathicharge on BPSC aspirants as "shameful and inhuman" and said the "double engine has become a symbol of double atrocities on the youth.'

On his social media handle, X Kharge said, "The brutal lathicharge and inhuman atrocities on BPSC candidates have been done by the NDA government of Bihar to hide paper leak and rigging.

He said that this was "An attempt to break the morale of the youth by using dictatorship against them is extremely shameful and condemnable."

He also accused the BJP of spreading a "web of paper leak mafia across the country,' which is ruining the future of



He said that in the last seven years, more than 70 paper leak incidents have taken place.

"When rigging is detected, the BJP shamelessly denies or tries to silence the youth by lathi-charging them.

The future of 3.28 lakh youth in the BPSC exam is hanging in the balance," Kharge said.

Meanwhile, Wayanad MP Priyanka Gandhi Vadra slammed the Bihar government and condemned the lathicharge on BPSC aspirants.

In a post on X, Vadra said, "BJP's double engine has become a symbol of double atrocities on the youth. Water cannon and lathicharge on youth in this harsh cold is inhuman". She said, "Students were

tortured for the second time in three days in Bihar. It is the government's job to stop corruption, rigging, and paper leaks in examinations. But instead of stopping corruption, students are being prevented from raising their voices.'
