

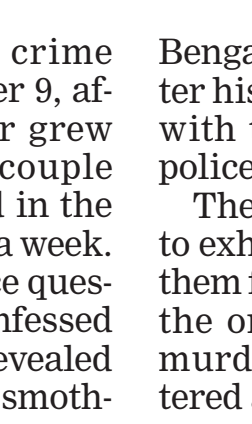
Woman murders two children with paramour

Suspicious graveyard worker alerts cops

In a horrific incident, a woman along with her paramour killed her three-year-old daughter and 11-month-old son, assuming that the children were an obstacle in their illicit relationship. The incident occurred in Ijor police limits in Ramanagara.

The police have arrested the accused -- **Sweetie** (24), a domestic help, and her paramour **Gregory Francis** (27), who works in a BPO, for allegedly murdering three-year-old Kabila and 11-month-old Kabilan. The accused were living in a rented house near Kemppegowda Circle in Ramanagara.



ered Kabila to death on October 1 and buried her in the graveyard, claiming that the child died because of an illness. A week later, on October 7, they smothered the 11-month-old baby and buried him in the same location. The graveyard worker, who grew suspicious, clicked a photograph of the couple and sent it to the cops, the police said.

The police further said that based on the photo, they tracked down the accused. During questioning, they confessed to the murders, stating that the children were an obstacle to their relationship.

"Sweetie's husband had filed a missing persons' complaint with the DJ Halli police in Bengaluru on September 19, after his wife left the house along with their two children," the police added.

The Ijor police are planning to exhume the bodies and send them for postmortem as part of the ongoing investigation. A murder case has been registered against the accused.

70-yr-old refuses to wear undergarment, murdered by son

A septuagenarian was killed by his son over the trivial issue of not wearing an undergarment, at Janata Colony on the outskirts of Bengaluru on Saturday night. The Bannerghatta police have arrested the accused.

The deceased, Velayudhan (76), hailing from Kerala, had health issues. The accused, Vinod Kumar (42), is a private firm employee.

The police said that around 11.30 am on Saturday, an argument broke out between the father and son, resulting in the murder. Vinod had asked his father to wear shorts under his dhoti, which led to a heated argument.

During the altercation, Vinod manhandled and punched Velayudhan, pushing him against a wall, causing a head injury. Velayudhan died before he was taken to a hospital.

After the incident, Kumar fled the scene and the family alerted the cops. The police arrived at the scene, sent the body for a postmortem, and arrested Vinod on Sunday morning.

Jailed murder accused threatens witnesses through social media

A jailed murder accused in the Bengaluru Central Prison at Parappana Agrahara has allegedly sent a voice message through social media to an autorickshaw driver, threatening the latter and other witnesses not to testify against him.

The Central Crime Branch (CCB) police have registered a case based on the auto driver's complaint. The victim, Arumugam -- a resi-

dent of LR Nagar, is a key witness in the murder of one Babli, who was killed in Koramangala two years ago. Somashekar alias Soma, a rowdy-sheeter, is an accused in the case.

According to the FIR, Arumugam on September 23 received three voice messages from an Instagram account -- 'Sajaga Soma'.

The sender had verbally abused Arumugam in Tamil and Kannada. He threatened that no one should testify in

the Joseph alias Babli murder case. He and other accused also said the messages should be passed on to Babli's wife, Sunil alias Sundili, George and Nathan.

The accused allegedly said that though he is in jail, he has managed to finish off Military Satish and the witnesses in the case could meet the same fate if they do not heed to his warning. He also warned that Arumugam will be bumped off if he does not pass the message to others.

The police are investigating in the matter.

'Many curricula don't address mental health issues'

ADDRESSING the immense academic and social pressures faced by students, both in the US and India, Dr Vivek Murthy said this pressure to succeed academically, coupled with comparison fostered by social media, can lead to significant stress. He called for urgent reforms in medical education to better integrate mental health training.

He mentioned that many medical curricula have not adequately addressed mental health issues, noting that for too long, mental and social

health have been viewed as less important than physical health. "To improve understanding, we need to cre-

ate experiential learning opportunities for medical students, such as engaging with individuals facing mental health challenges," he explained.

Expressing concern over loneliness, he highlighted that it is not about being physically alone, but it is a subjective feeling of disconnection. He argued that health insurance companies must take the same amount of time to reimburse mental healthcare claims as physical healthcare claims as it is vital to ensure everyone has access to necessary mental health support.

Five-year-old mowed down by mini-truck

Bengaluru: A five-year-old boy died after falling under the wheels of a mini-truck on Friday. The incident occurred at Govindapur road in the KG Halli police station limits. The deceased Taher Pasha, is a resident of Byatarayanpura. The police stated that Taher was visiting his grandmother's house for the holidays. On Friday evening, while heading home after playing with friends, he accidentally hit his shoulder on the handlebar of a parked scooter on the roadside, leading to a fall, when a mini truck knocked him down. After hearing the scream, the family and other residents rushed him to a nearby hospital, where doctors declared him brought dead. The incident was recorded on a CCTV camera of a nearby house. The police arrested the driver, Prasanth.
