

Ajit Pawar slams divisive politics

Calls for unity and integrity in Maharashtra; hits out at opposition over EVM stance

Deputy Chief Minister Ajit Pawar emphasised the importance of unity and secularism in Maharashtra, cautioning against divisive politics and efforts to incite communal hatred. Speaking at the inauguration of the Nationalist Congress Party's (NCP) district office on Monday, Pawar reaffirmed the party's dedication to the principles of Shahu Maharaj, Jyotirao Phule, and Dr B R Ambedkar.

"Maharashtra has always stood as a beacon of progressive thought and social harmony. Our party will continue to uphold secular ideals and will not tolerate any attempts to disrupt communal peace," said Pawar. He also advised party members to refrain from including tainted individuals in the party.

Marathas show black flags to Pawar

Activists of the Maratha Mahasangh staged a protest on Monday by showing black flags to Pawar during his visit to Jalna. The demonstration, led by district president Arvind Deshmukh, was in response to the Massajog sarpanch Santosh Deshmukh in Beed and the custodial death of law student Somnath Suryawanshi in Parbhani.

Protesters demanded swift justice for the victims and accountability from the government. "As the guardian minister of Beed, Pawar must ensure justice for the families of the sarpanch and the Dalit activist," said Deshmukh.

Pawar also criticised opposition parties for their contradictory stance on electronic voting machines (EVMs). "When they win elections in Karnataka and West Bengal, they praise EVMs. But when they lose, they blame the same machines," he remarked.

ernment elections, Pawar urged them to strengthen the party's presence through dedication. He also encouraged farmers to adopt modern agricultural practices to boost productivity and resilience. Lineman on pole dies from shock

Relatives hold company responsible for his death

In a tragic incident, a contractual lineman of the Maharashtra State Electricity Distribution Company Ltd (MSEDCL) died on the spot after sustaining a heavy electric shock while performing his duty on the top of a pole in Purna town of the district late Sunday evening.

Tension in company office The deceased, identified as Vishal Jogdand, is aged around 25 years and is survived by his mother, father, brother, and sister. Tension prevailed in the company's town office after Vishal's relatives held the negligence of the company officers responsible for his death. The tension escalated when they refused to give permission to perform a post-mortem on the body.

However, they were pacified and gave consent for the post-mortem following the intervention of police officers into the matter. Huge police force deployed

According to the sources, Vishal climbed up on the pole to regularise electric supply. He was performing his duty on the pole when he sustained a high-voltage shock after the power supply resumed. This left Vishal dead on the spot.

A large group of Vishal's relatives gathered at the MSEDCL office on Monday morning seeking action against the officers responsible for his death. This triggered tension in the area. The situation returned to normalcy after police force from the Purna, Chudawa, and Tadkalas police stations was deployed in the local hospital.

However, they gave their consent to the post-mortem in the afternoon after the intervention of senior officials. The last rites were performed on him in the evening at the crematorium in Purna.

During the recent Assembly elections, he sought a ticket from the Shiv Sena (Shinde faction) but was not granted one. He had filed his nomination for the Ghansawangi Assembly segment, though Ardad later withdrew his candidacy.



Hearing on Karad's bail plea on Thursday

The hearing on the bail application of Walmik Karad, who was remanded to judicial custody by the Kaij Court under the Maharashtra Control of Organised Crime Act (MCOCA), has been postponed once again. The case involves allegations of threatening officials of the Avaada windmill project in Massajog, Kaij tehsil. The hearing is now scheduled for Thursday in the Kaij Court.

Karad was initially remanded to judicial custody on January 14 in connection with an extortion case. His lawyer Adv Siddheshwar Thombare, filed a bail application in the same court. During the initial hearing on January 16, public prosecutor Adv Jitendra Shinde presented arguments, and the court



scheduled the next hearing for Saturday, January 18. However, on Saturday, Adv Ashok Kawade, representing Karad, requested a postponement citing an eyeache. The hearing was subsequently rescheduled for Monday, January 20. Karad's lawyer again filed an application to defer the hearing on Monday, claiming they had not received the copy of the statement from the prosecution. The court, presided over by magistrate S V Pawaskar, rejected the request but directed the prosecution to provide the required documents. Following this, the court scheduled the bail hearing for Thursday.

Elderly rider killed in head-on collision

A 65-year-old man, a resident of Ghugewadi village in Shirur Kasar tehsil, lost his life after his motorcycle collided with a car from the opposite direction on the Beed-Shirur Kasar road on Monday.

The accident occurred at 11.30 am when Chepate was travelling towards Beed on his motorcycle, resulting in severe injuries. Chepate died while being shifted to the hospital. Local police have initiated further investigations into the incident.

₹10 lakh for kin of bus accident deceased

Beed: A financial assistance of Rs 10 lakh will be provided to the families of those who lost their lives in the Maharashtra State Road Transport Corporation (MSRTC) bus accident at Rajuri (Ghodke) in Beed tehsil. The tragic incident occurred on the Beed-Parli Vajjanath road on Sunday.

MLA Sandeep Kshirsagar from Beed contacted transport minister Pratap Sarnaik, who promptly announced the compensation. Sarnaik also instructed the MSRTC's managing director to ensure the financial aid reaches the affected families at the earliest.

The accident claimed the lives of three teenagers Virat Ghodake, Om Ghodake, and Subodh More. The trio had been practicing running drills in preparation for police constable recruitment exams when the unfortunate tragedy struck.
